




## **Prayer Requests**

## Back to the DRC!



Monday, May 17, we board the plane on our way to the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC). The past few months have been interesting, fundraising didn't go as well as we'd hoped and we still are in need of at least \$7,000 in order to purchase a reliable 4WD vehicle. However, this has not deterred us at all from the mission. Jesus is making us walk in faith. We can't make decisions based on lack, but only based on faith according to the will of God. It's hard to communicate the anxious excitement, and even more, the sobering responsibility of reality we have springing up from in us. We have been challenged to new places in our

prayer lives and have grown up so much this year. We are so thankful to be called by the King of Kings to reach His people. . .

We've spent a lot of time digging for other ministries in the DRC who have a similar vision and creating a relationship with them. This summer, we will partner with several of them including one who is planting churches on the Congo-Uganda border. We will be serving on their base for an extended period of time. This ministry has been in Central Africa for over 20 years and has accumulated a lot of valuable insight. This is an opportunity to for us to learn from other experienced missionaries and evangelists as we reach the people of the DRC.

Once our feet hit the ground, our number one goal is this: the presence of Jesus, invading the North Kivu, DRC. Prayer is the foundation, gathering church leaders and anyone who is willing to come; we are going to unite many different tribes under the

banner of prayer. In this region, it's very difficult for leaders to be united, because of differences amongst tribes. Pray that the spirit of God will draw Church leaders together and purge out bitterness, selfishness and prejudice.

A small team will be joining us from June 9-26. They are helping us with larger events like a pastor's conference, orphans outreaches and tent to tent ministry in the internally displaced people camps. We are also traveling to some of the rural areas to minister in the churches and visit hut to hut.



I (Amethyst) will be continuing to work with women, conducting workshops and bible studies. Since, most of the ladies don't know how to read, it is very difficult for them to know who they are in Christ. I have practiced reading in Swahili, so that daily I can read out loud the Bible to any women who choose to come and hear. We also

would like to bless one woman's group with some sewing machines to teach some practical sewing skills to women who need work.

The great needs in this area can be overwhelming. Our work can be seen as insignificant, but we understand that humble beginnings are necessary to accomplish the greater picture. We need to be the hands and feet of Jesus; we believe that God is going to do miracles like the he did when Jesus fed 5,000 people (and their families). We are expecting to see the miraculous draw more people to Jesus.

Please continue to send your financial gifts to our PO Box while we are gone. Someone will be diligently checking and depositing all the money. In our last efforts to raise funds we have been calling for 100 individuals or churches to donate a one-time gift of \$100. This would meet out financial goal to purchase these vehicles in the DRC.
