

Wow, praise the Lord! Where do we begin?

It has been nearly six months since you've last received a newsletter from us. The last time you read one we were just setting foot on Congolese soil. One newsletter can hardly detail the events of this summer. A hundred pictures wouldn't convey enough words.

In our absence of newsletters, we hope you've had a chance to keep up with our blogs/updates via our website www.the-roths.weebly.com and Facebook throughout the summer. You can go back and look at the archives on our website.

We ministered in the Democratic Republic of Congo from May through August and then August to September we spent time acquainting ourselves with a like-hearted ministry in Uganda. To summarize the whole summer, Jesus showed up and thousands were impacted by the Word of God, hundreds came to faith and many experienced the miracle healing of God. God was magnificently exalted. How amazing to have had the opportunity to be used by God in such a manner!

Despite not having the funds to buy a vehicle, God used our humble means and God was sufficient in our lack. We bought a motorbike which got us everywhere we needed to go and allowed us to do everything we needed to do: ministry within the city, reaching remote villages, visiting internally displaced people (IDP) camps and everything else needed to be done.

As we ministered the Word of God in pastors conferences, visited the believers in IDP camps, lead intercessory prayer groups and reached out to orphans in the slums, Jesus showed up and lives were forever changed. Our contacts have been instrumental in helping us assess objectives for future ministry. They have served in translating, arranging logistics and most of all, as true partners in the harvest. Without them no ministry could be done. Through these contacts, God has provided us with a solid foundation instrumental for long-term success.

To cap off the summer, we spent a month in Uganda visiting a ministry called World Outreach Ministry Foundation (WOMF.) Papa Ron and Mama Shirley DeVore along with Pastor Steven Mayanja (a Ugandan) started the ministry 23 years ago to make an impact upon war deprived and spiritually devastated Uganda.

With over 150 churches planted (which have in turn planted an innumerable amount of daughter churches), work being done in seven countries and millions who've felt the effects of this ministry, it was suggested by some of our church elders to visit them.

Learning from WOMF has been a huge blessing and in any true mentor/discipleship it is a two way street. We got to capture much needed and desired media (both pictures and photos) for them. They have never had a dedicated media person to help in such a capacity for even such a short period of time... WOMF has taught us much about how to run and operate an international organization: both the business and spiritual aspects... If each nugget of wisdom gained were equivalent to an ounce of gold, we'd be millionaires.

Thank you everyone for your prayers and support. If we could sit down and thank each one of you on our mail and e-mail lists individually we would, regardless of whether or not you've given us even a penny!

With the ending of one chapter and opening of another, a new work has just begun. After this summer's assessment we see three critical items to arrange before moving to Congo full-time. It is necessary to have a capable four-wheel drive vehicle: without one, we'll be forever crippled in our impact. Another need is to build a safe and secure compound where we'll be living. Finally, the last major hurdle to overcome is to file the necessary paperwork to be recognized as an NGO in the DR Congo.

Jesus is our provider and with Him there is always enough, no matter the obstacles, no matter the needs. In our lack, Jesus becomes lifted higher and His glory becomes greater. He will provide! Lift us up in prayer as we step into this next chapter on our journey

into the heart of God, reaching His people and impacting as many as possible in the process!
